Alderman John Parker commented on the water meters at the Avalon and Pershing sites - they were signed off on appropriation by the end of the month. The Parks Department will pay the water bill and maintain both sites.

There was a complaint mentioned about the cargo containers at the Kroger store on Pike Avenue.

Cary Gaines shared about the lights being put in on MacArthur Drive right by the freeway. Also landscape plans are in the works for that area by the Highway Department.

The vehicles coming off the freeway have the right of way and when anyone is trying to make a right hand turn onto Avalon, must make a hard right turn after the solid white line. Very hard to do. Just wanted to let everyone know that you could get a ticket if you cross that solid white line.
